Day 1: Arrival to Ho Chi Minh city – Half day city tour



Morning flight to Ho Chi Minh city (airfare is not included); Arrive in Ho Chi Minh city (Saigon), pick up and transfer to the city centre & check in hotel (check in time from 2pm on ward). Today you will visit half day Saigon city tour, the first place is The Independence Palace symbolizes Vietnam's victory, peace, and territorial integrity. This place has a glamorous design, hundreds of rooms equipped with luxurious furnishings and decorations, and an enormous and gorgeous exterior space; next is War Remnants Museum: Formerly known as the Museum of American War Crimes, this is a poignant display of the futility of war, the museum is a call for peace and hopes that history does not repeat itself; continue to Notre Dame Cathedral and Old Post Office: Built between 1877 and 1883 this is one of the best examples of classical French colonial architecture. End of the tour is Ben Thanh Market: This bustling market is very popular with tourists, primarily due to its central location. It has a wide selection of goods ranging from fake Nike shoes to beautiful silk Ao Dais. Overnight in Ho Chi Minh city

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Day 2: Ho Chi Minh city - Cu Chi Tunnel – Ho Chi Minh city (B)



Morning, we will drive overland to Cu Chi Tunnels, an incredible underground network constructed by Vietnamese guerrillas to protect the region against the American attacks during the Vietnam War. The tunnels were used by Viet Cong soldiers as hiding spots during combat, as well as serving as communication and supply routes, hospitals, food and weapon caches and living quarters for numerous North Vietnamese fighters. The tunnel systems were of great importance to the Viet Cong in their resistance to American forces, and helped to counter the growing American military effort. We can even crawl a part inside the tunnel, visit their infirmary, kitchen.... to discover how people had survived hereby. Back to Hochiminh city in the afternoon and free to discover city by your own way. Overnight in Hochiminh city

Day 3: Ho Chi Minh city - Flight to Da Nang- City tour half day (B)



Morning flight to Da Nang city (airfare is not included); Arrival to Da Nang, pick up and transfer to hotel for checking in (check in time 2pm). Relax and refresh after flight.

Start the tour by visiting Marble Mountains is a cluster of five marble and limestone hills located in Ngũ Hành Sơn District, south of Da Nang city in Vietnam. The mountain is dotted with hundreds of caves, shrines, statues, and pagodas. As you make your way up the first set of steps to the first landing, you'll soon comet the first small Buddhist temple. Every sight and stop along the trail up the mountain is unique and well-worth a visit. As you climb higher up the steep and sometimes slippery marble steps, occasionally the thick jungle surrounding the path will clear, giving an unparalleled view of the breathtaking My Khe nearby. If you are feeling really adventurous, head to the highest point on the mountain for an incredible view of the sea and surrounding landscape. Continue to cross Dragon Bridge, the icon bridge of Da Nang city, you can walk along the bridge for a while. The next place is Linh Ung Son Tra Pagoda is the largest pagoda in Da Nang City in both term of scale (about 20ha) and artistic architecture. The pagoda is situated on Monkey



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mountain in the Son Tra Peninsula. It is built with the harmonious combination of the modernity and the tradition of Vietnamese pagoda's architecture. Linh Ung Pagoda now is one of appealing tourist attractions of the beautiful coastal city. This is also the harmony between the sea and the mountain in a quiet space, along with the murmur of the sea; simultaneously, the pagoda is also the special place linking Heaven and Earth. The last place is visiting local market, free for shopping around about half an hour before going back to hotel.

Day 4: Da Nang – Basket boat in Cam Thanh village – Hoi An Ancient town (B)



Start the tour by visiting Cam Thanh water coconut forest, which is located just about 5kms from the southeast of the Hoi An Old Town and easy to approach by car. With an airy, large, wide space and beautiful water coconut palm forest, The Coconut village is an attractive and favorite spot for visitors from Hoi An and other places to visit and explore. You will experience basket boat ride around the coconut forest, learn about the daily life of Vietnamese fishermen, their families and their community. During the trip, the boatman will take coconut leaves to make funny natural ornaments such as hats, rings, glasses ... extremely lovely for you. You will surely experience the feeling of floating on the waves of water and join a equally fun basket boat race between the baskets together in the cheering and bustling music drum...

Continue the tour to Hoi An ancient town, also known as Faifo, thanks to favorable geographic and climatic factors, Hoi An was a busy international port, where the Japanese, Chinese and Western merchant ships met during the 17th and 18th centuries. Hoi An town with its peace and ancient has become one of the most popular tourist attractions that appeal to the travelers of all tastes and cross over the continents. In 1999, Hoi An was recognized by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. Exploring Hoi An on foot is one of the best ways to absorb the beauty of this city. While walking around Hoi An, exploring the small yet beautiful town, which tourists (even frequent visitors) find to be a place of quiet and peace. The unique atmosphere combines elements of Vietnam, China and Japan. The most remarkable views are from the ancient houses, reminding visitors of a long gone past and providing a momentary glimpse of a more subdued and simple time. Visit to Hoi An Market, Hoi An Museum, many of the town's renowned Ancient Houses which boast a remarkable architectural style, Assembly Halls of Chinese influence, Art Craft Manufacturing and of course the must-see Japanese Covered Bridge. These spots are considered as typical architecture styles in Hoi An and reflect clearly the cross culture among France, Japan, China and Vietnam. Passing over hundreds of years and withstanding the severity of the weather, Hoi An still exists and keeps the ancient and quiet beauty... Free for shopping till going back to your hotel.



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Day 5: Danang- Full day Bana Hill- Golden Bridge – Da Nang (B)



Morning, transfer to Ba Na Hills, pass the sea-shore on Nguyen Tat Thanh Street, one of the most beautiful roads of Da Nang City and Red Beach, where the French first landed in Da Nang.

Arrive at the Cable car station at the foot of Ba Na Mountain. Enjoy the first leg Cable car, which achieves two Guinness World Records in 2009, longest non-stop cable car (5,042m) and highest non-stop cable car (1,292m). Sitting in the cabin, in mid air, looking upon the endless tree line of the forests, bring you with spectacular views of the lush jungle and fairly waterfalls along the way. First, step on Golden Bridge which stands 1,400m above sea level in the Ba Na hills, extends over the treetops from the edget of a leafy cliff face offering tourists uninterrupted views of the majestic landscape beneath. The Golden Bridge is the latest tourist attraction in Da Nang and has attracted hordes of guests since it opened.

Visit the Le Jardin garden, remains of French Villas and Ling Ung Pagoda with 27m high Buddha status. We then leave the Le Jardin for the second cable car station to visit the top of mountain and see the remain of old villas. Conquer the Peak of Chua Mountain at the height of 1,487m. View the whole Da Nang city under the cluster of white clouds. Leave Peak of Chua Mountain, visit the trail of Dreaming Stream, Rainbow Waterfall, Suspension Bridge, Golden Valley, and ruined Opera House. Enjoy 105 free games t Fantasy Park and speed slide...Play with wild monkeys and take photos, freely then we return to Cable car station at foot of Ba Na Mountain then transfer to Danang. Overnight in Danang.

Day 6: Da Nang - Flight to Hanoi - Hanoi city tour (B)



Morning flight to Hanoi city (airfare is not included); Arrival to Hanoi, pick up and transfer to



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hotel for checking in (check in time 2pm). Relax and refresh after flight.

Then, we start half day Hanoi city tour. Hanoi has always been a symbol of culture and a source of pride throughout the history, bustling Hanoi offers a charming blend of new and old. The French-colonial era has left a legacy of beautiful buildings, with the Old Quarter a fascinating area to explore on foot... Begin to the tour to Center of Vietnam's government: Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum with Ba Dinh square where all important events of the country will be taken place here, opposite Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum is Vietnam Parliament House, and beside is President Palace. Next place is one of the most beautiful Pagoda of Hanoi name Tran Quoc pagoda on an island of Hanoi West Lake, Tran Quoc Pagoda is regarded as the most ancient pagoda in Hanoi with its history line dating back to more than 1,500 years, it is A cultural relic - A religious institute - A historical witness. Continue to Hoan Kiem Lake where is central point of Hanoi city, visit King Ly Thai To statue, learn more about history of more than 1000 years of Hanoi capital; then enjoy walking around Hanoi Old Quarter with small streets & old houses, feel friendly people with typical Vietnamese smiles offer you the true feeling of this capital city... Return to your hotel & Overnight in Hanoi.

Day 7: Hanoi - Ninh Binh – Trang An cave (or Tam Coc) & Hoa Lu – Hanoi (B)



Start our day tour to Ninh Binh province where you will come first is Trang An, take a small sampan wooden boat trip slowly rowing through serpentine streams, between the blooming mountains and valleys. The 2.5 hour rowing boat takes you to sacred sites and through some mysterious water caves (there are 3 direction options). Along the way, there are spectacular transitions as you get into a dark cave and a whole new picture appears right in front of your eyes at the exit. Follow the boat's schedule, you can drop off the sampan boat to visit some on-land attractions. We can enjoy the fresh air, clean and clear water with underwater grass. Experience ourselves the feeling and emotion when we are in the water caves. After discovery in Trang An, we move to Hoa Lu Ancient capital situated 7km from Trang An to continue our day tour in Ninh Binh. Upon arrival, ornate temples that worship the Emperors will catch your eyes at first sight. These temples were constructed to honor King Dinh Tien Hoang, King Le Dai Hanh, and King Ly Thai To. On the site, you are told about the story of the first three centralized feudal states of Vietnam: the Ding dynasty, the Le dynasty, and the Ly dynasty. Go back to Hanoi and overnight in Hanoi



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Day 8: Hanoi - Ha Long bay with Overnight on Cruise (B/L/D)



Today we leave Hanoi to Halong bay, "Dragon Descending to the Sea". Halong Bay is one of the most beautiful and impressive sights in Vietnam. Ha long Bay has twice been recognized by UNESCO as a World Natural Heritage Area for its exceptional scenic beauty and one of the world's greatest natural wonders. Upon arrival, we will embark to an overnight Cruise; Check in your beautiful room with ocean view from your bed. Have Sea food Lunch at cruise's luxury restaurant while the cruise goes around limestone islands, floating villages and beaches on Ha Long bay... Stop for Swimming, Kayaking if weather permitted. Have dinner on board. Overnight on board.

Day 9: Ha Long Bay - Hanoi - Departure (B/Brunch)



Early morning experience Tai Chi exercise on the top deck of the Cruise or enjoy sunrise behind mountains on the bay. Having light breakfast and continue the cruise to see other part of Halong Bay.

Having Brunch on the cruise and disembark at around 11:30 am and return to Hanoi in the afternoon. Transfer to airport for departure flight.
